The Good Dinosaur

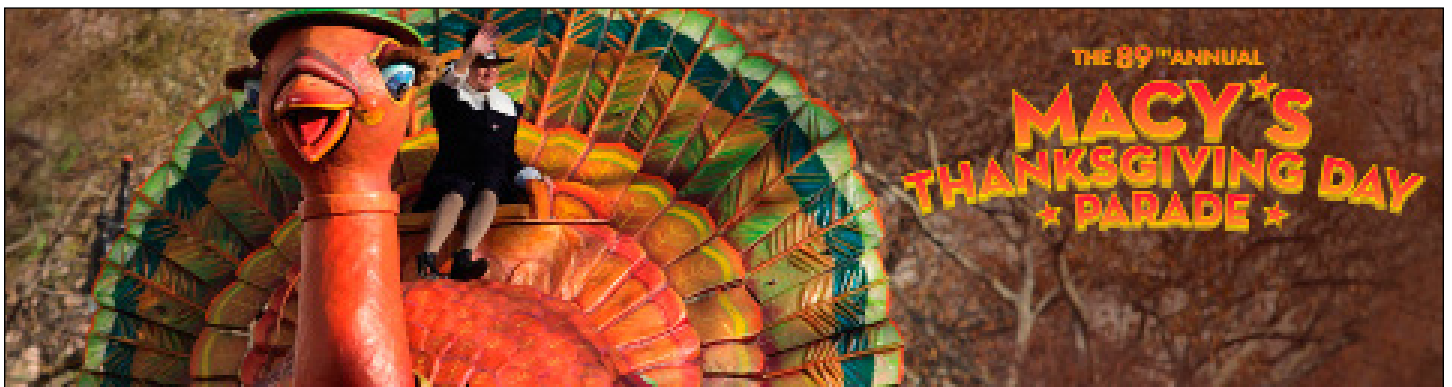
