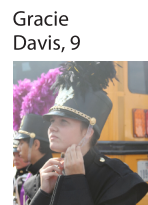

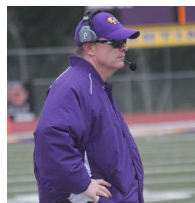

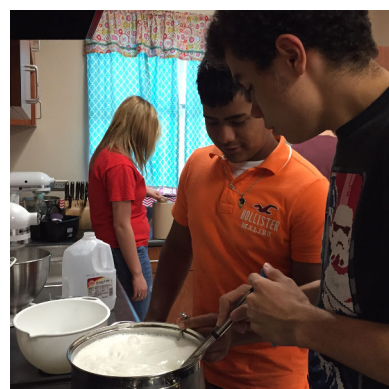

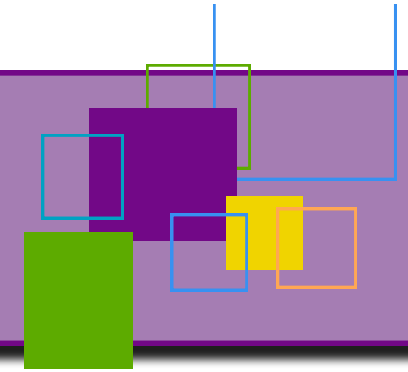

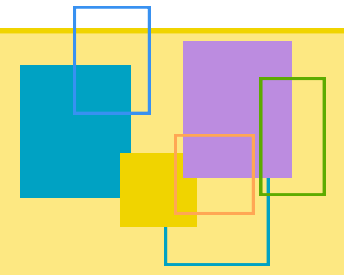

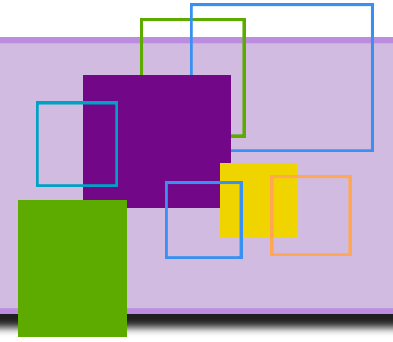

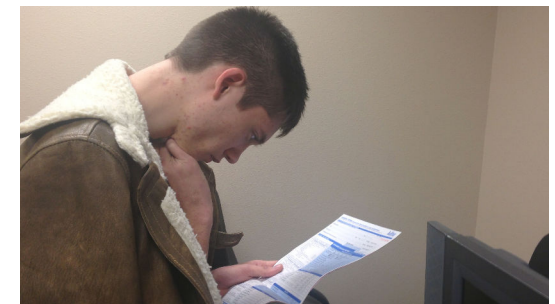

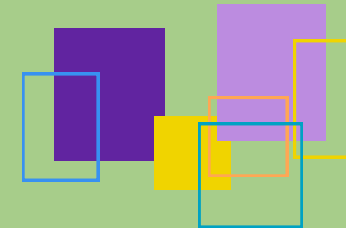

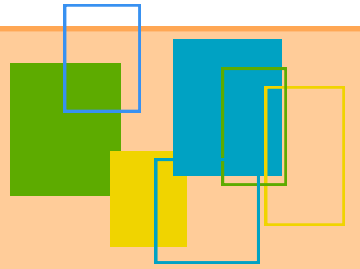

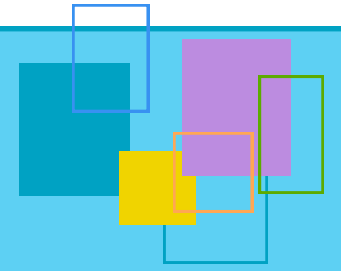

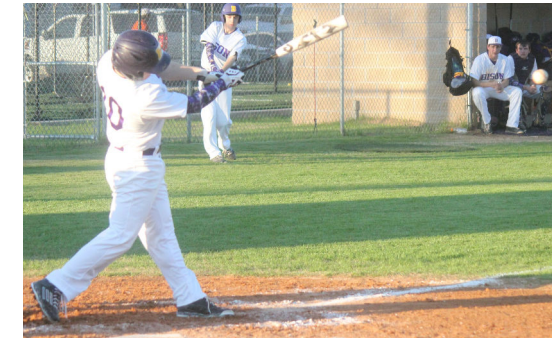

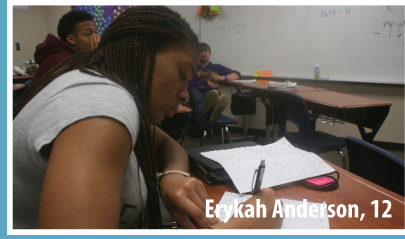

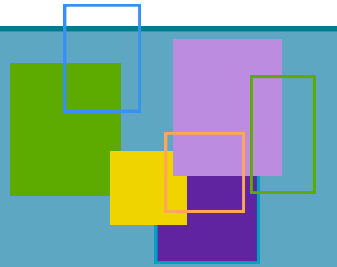

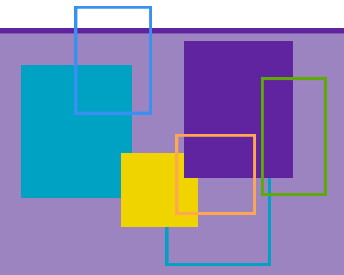

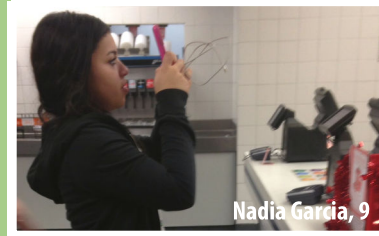

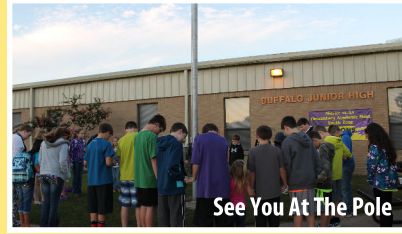

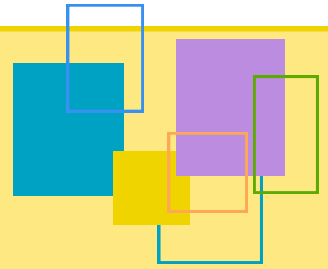

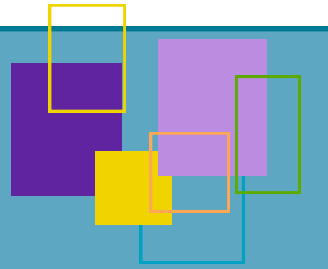

## colophon

The 2015 Bison, Volume 68, press run was 101 copies of 176 pages, printed on 80-pound, glossy paper. Times Roman 10-point was used for copy and Myriad Pro 8 point was used for captions. Ad Lib and Annie were the other primary fonts used. School portraits, including senior portraits, school pictures and team/organization photos, were done by Lifetouch Photography out of Tyler, Texas. Brad Burkett, Curt Malone and Charlie Falco were photography representatives. Other photos were taken by the journalism staff, with contributions by BISD staff members. The staff used digital photography primarily taken with a Cannon Rebel; some photos were taken using iPads and iPhones. Any photo editing was done using Adobe PhotoShop. The book was prepared using Lifetouch's WebEase online program on Dell computers and Chromebooks. The cover is matte and incorporates both debossing and glossy printing. Cover artist was Tug Newett with Lifetouch publishing. The book was published by Lifetouch Publishing. Yearbook representatives were Kim Weaver and Shannon Cook out of Tyler, Texas. The cost of each book was \$35 in early sales and \$50 thereafter. Publication cost was approximately \$62 per book. The yearbook staff holds memberships with the Interscholastic League Press Conference, Southern Interscholastic Press Association, Quill and Scroll, Journalism Educators Association, Texas Association of Journalism Educators and Association of Texas Photography Instructors. The staff also publishes the online newspaper at [www.bisonbeat.net](http://www.bisonbeat.net) and has a Facebook group titled The Bison Beat. The 2014-2015 journalism staff had ten members who worked on all publications. The editor was Jordan Jenkins, with Brittney Scott and Erykah Anderson acting as assistant editors. Staff members were Kendall Morales, Sarah Burchfield, Ally Gaskins, Miryam Zapata, Lilah Molina, Garrett McAlpine and Lauren Beshears.

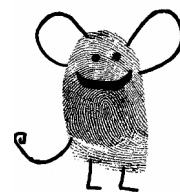

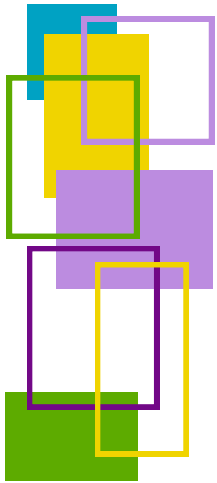

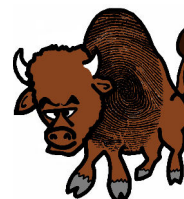
