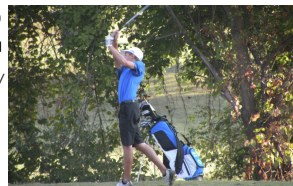

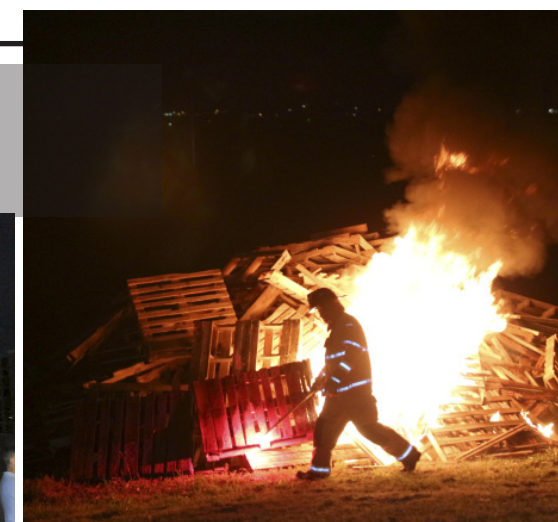
Battle of Big Sandy

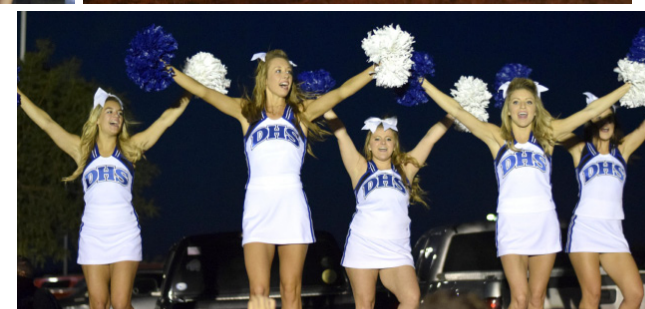
