## Timberwolves spend time outside the classroom

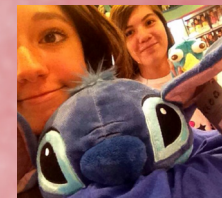
**Q:** What's your favorite thing to do locally?
