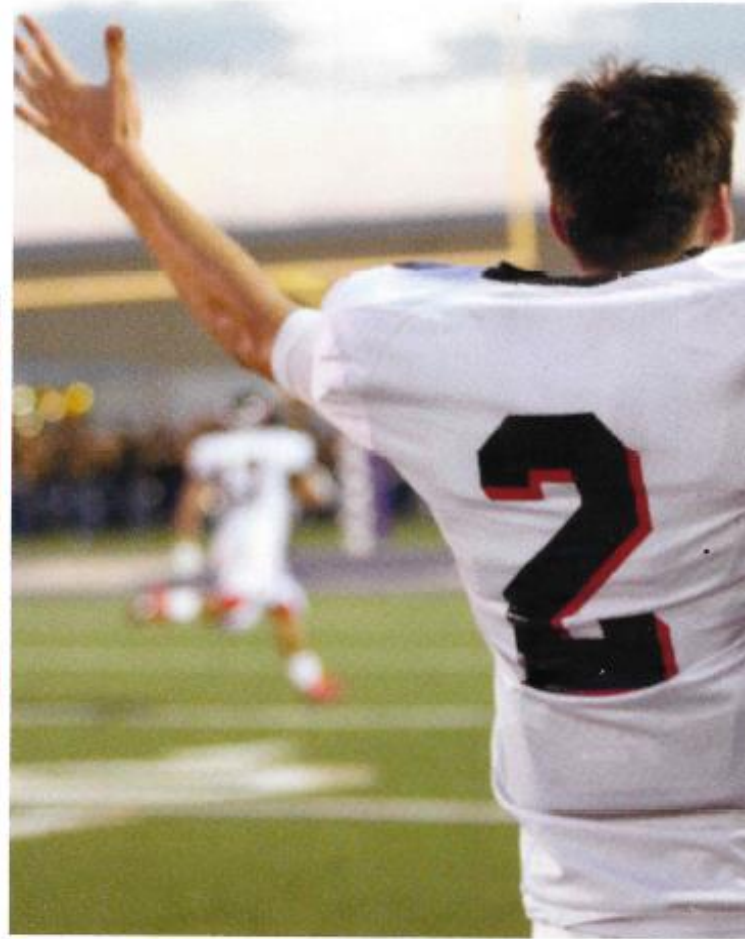




Go Braves!
