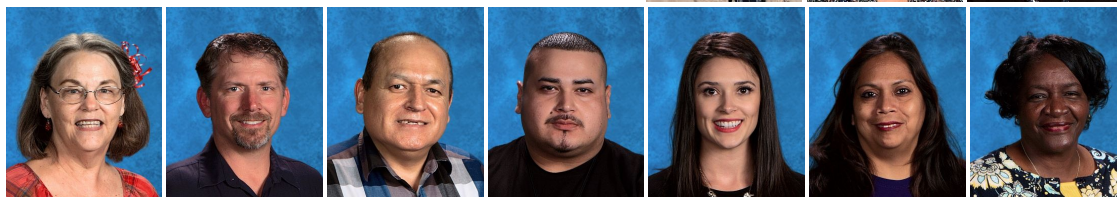

"The friendships I see in the hallways and how it seems like everyone is one big family where everyone knows everyone really reminds me of my school years."



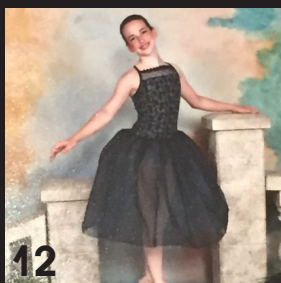

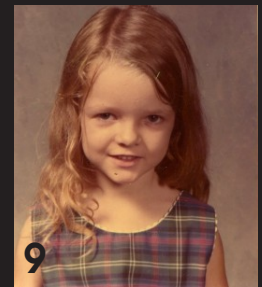
