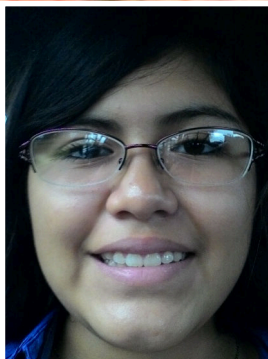
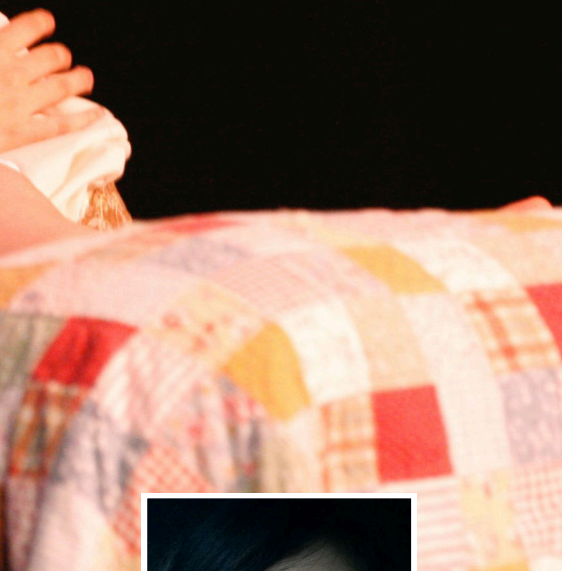
“This was such a great experience,” sophomore Gracie Davis said. “I’m so happy I got to

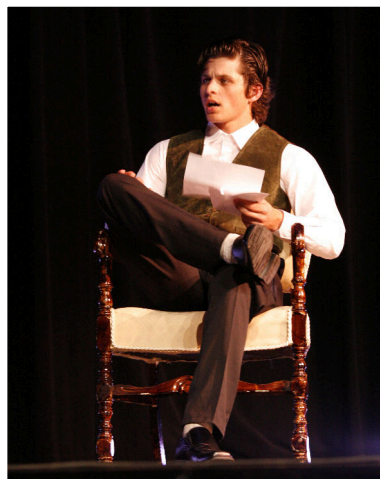
