High school principal faces cancer diagnosis

Assistant principal, Amy Billingslea's voice filled the school as she called for all teachers to report to the Plato Lab for a faculty meeting. The unexpected announcement brought the teachers and staff to high alert as they knew something was wrong. Superintendent, Mike Gilbert, stood in front of the staff with tears in his eyes as he told them that Dan Noll would be having surgery to place a metal rod inside his femur to support his bone. Noll had been told only the day before that parts of his body were consumed with advanced bone cancer.

Upon receiving the news, Counselor Jack Hale asked the teary-eyed teachers to all circle up, join hands and turn to God for protection over principal, Dan Noll.

Noll was diagnosed with Stage 3 Multiple Myeloma bone cancer, a cancer that is not curable, but treatable with chemotherapy. Noll will begin therapy on March 8.

Even though Noll faces a struggle in the future, he continues to display his faith during difficult times.


