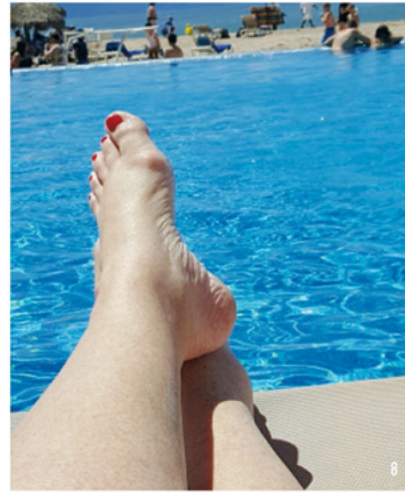


TIME FOR A VACAY
